School Watch

Please note that no-one (including students) is allowed in the school grounds out-of-school hours unless they have permission from the principal. Students may access the tennis court but may not go near school buildings. Please advise us with a courtesy call if your child would like access to the tennis court and be aware that parents are responsible for their child/ren at all times. We will be replacing the lock as it has been damaged. Climbing the high fence is a safety issue and we have been advised that this practice has been happening. Please be mindful of the neighbours when using the court as they have been subjected to loud, foul language.

While we encourage exercise, our facilities must not be damaged and we need to keep everyone safe and happy. Ensure children have a water bottle as they cannot go under the buildings to get a drink.

Lately we have had some "visitors" who have vandalised our property which is worrying. Please reinforce with your children so they are aware that they are not allowed near school buildings or in the playground, even to get a drink.

Contact us to let us know if your child/ren will be using the tennis court and to find out the combination for the lock when we have secured it. Thank you for your help with this.
